Purpose:

The purpose of the FFAF Scholarship is to recognize, encourage, and support graduating students who have prevailed over obstacles to personal success and academic achievement.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Candidate must be accepted into fulltime attendance at a post-secondary program (apprenticeship, college, university).
2. Candidate must be between 17 and 21 years old and demonstrate an element of financial need to receive the award.
3. Candidate must demonstrate academic, athletic, and or social excellence within the community.
4. Candidate must be a resident of the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) and be available for an interview.
5. Students selected to receive the award must attend the Scholarship Dinner function in order to receive the award.
6. The award scholarship shall have a value of up to \$1000.00
